Year in review: In spite of the pandemic, our board functioned with lots of emails, telephone calls, and zoom meetings. Highlights during year included: Community Yard sale was held in October with at least 20 participating homes; Food trucks visited us weekly throughout the year; Trimming of all Evergreen St Elm Trees and Frye Rd Palo Verdes was completed, and in Jan 2022, 11 Eucalyptus in the basin were trimmed. The monsoon destroyed a number of Palo Verdes along Frye, and a plan was submitted to the City to plant an assortment of hardier, more appropriate trees, some now and more later as additional Palo Verde's fail; A large Eucalyptus tree along Fairview was removed as its roots lifted and it leaned creating a safety hazard; A major irrigation project was completed in the basin to allow trees to be watered separately from the turf to allow turf water to be turned off as needed without affecting the trees. Feral cats continue to be a challenge and we have Trapped/Neutered/Released (TNR) more cats. There is nothing else we can legally do.

Our Annual Meeting was conducted on Zoom December 8th, 2021 at which time Rich Sisco was re-elected to the board for an additional 3 year term. Rich has been an invaluable board member, designing and creating significant and complex beautification plans resulting in numerous additional plants and trees throughout our neighborhood.



Such items include: wall painting, dry well repairs and cleaning, granite replacement, irrigation line replacements, and other major repairs.
